العيد الوطني
Public holiday, folk concerts and fireworks.
- عيد الفطر**
Streets and public places are decorated days in advance,
People go to prayer in the morning in new clothes,
At home, friends and family enjoy visiting, and eat (traditional) sweets. As for children, they spend most of their time playing and buying gifts.
- شم النسيم**
Is a national holiday. Families go out to public parks for picnicking, and enjoy watching the dancing and singing parties.
On this occasion, people eat popular dishes, especially "fesikh", which is a type of salted fish.

عيد الميلاد

Holding special prayers, and religious ceremonies in churches.

The most distinctive feature of this holiday is the visit from Father Christmas and the Christmas tree decorated with lights, and colourful bulbs.

On this day, people gather, eat Christmas dinner, exchange gifts.

عيد الأضحى

Muslims congratulate each other and give Eid money (called Eidiya) to children, meat is distributed to the poor, and people enjoy visiting relatives, eating traditional food, and exchanging gifts.

عيد يناير

Families gather at home, eat traditional dishes, such as: "Couscous" and "Chakchouka" and eating dessert that has dried fruits, nuts and dates.
